TEMPORARY LOCAL WINTER RULES

Please note that until further notice, the following conditions apply:-

1) Local Rule - Lift Clean and Place

A ball coming to rest on any closely mown area may, without penalty, be moved or may be lifted, cleaned if so desired, and placed, within 6 inches of where it originally lay, no nearer the hole. After the ball has been so moved or placed, it is in play.

2) Local Rule - Winter Greens

Any ball coming to rest on the Temporary Winter Green when playing the Permanent Green or on the Permanent Green when playing the Temporary Winter Green may either

- Be lifted, cleaned if required and dropped within one club length of the nearest point off the Green but not nearer the hole.

Or

- Using the putter only be played as it lies after cleaning if required.

3) Local Rule- Aeration holes or lines

If a ball comes to rest in an aeration hole or line, the player may, without penalty, lift the ball and clean it. Through the green, the player shall drop the ball as near as possible to where it lay, but not nearer the hole. On the putting green, the player shall place the ball at the nearest spot not nearer the hole, which avoids such situation.

4) Local Rule - Embedded Ball, Through the Green

A ball embedded in its own pitch mark in the ground through the green may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole. (Local Rules 1 shall then apply)

5) Local Rule – Newly filled divots

A ball coming to rest **on the fairway**, in a divot which has been newly filled must, without penalty, be lifted, cleaned if so desired and dropped within one club length, not nearer the hole.

6) GUR - Play Prohibited

All repaired drain lines, newly turfed or seeded areas, or any area marked with a white line, including areas of newly planted trees, are declared GUR from which **play is prohibited** and the player should proceed in accordance with Rule 25-1.

Please note that relief from the areas of GUR of newly planted trees alongside the 7th and 8th holes is at the **NEAREST** point of relief and **NOT** only on the fairway side.

Please also note that the trees to the left of the 4th, 5th and 6th fairways previously marked with white lines are **NO LONGER** to be regarded as GUR
